

Carrier Bond Facility for Canadian ACI Bonds (REVISED Dec 2017)

How to apply for a Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) Marine Carrier Bond through Shoreline

Complete and return scanned copies of the forms below completed to the best of your ability to Shoreline Ltd. at shore@shoreline.bm.

- Application to Transact Marine Carrier Operations with the Canada Border Services Agency (BSF329-4)
- Canadian Power of Attorney
- Canada Customs Bond

Shoreline will send to you:

- An electronic confirmation of the application please verify info is correct. This application requests some additional information not on the Canadian MCC application that is required for SIM to complete the Travelers Bond application on your behalf. Please return an updated copy of the application or just advise us of any missing information at shore@shoreline.bm;
- An invoice for the Bond with wire payment instructions. Cost is \$1,050 USD for a 3-year term;
- An additional Attestation form. This does not need to be returned to Shoreline.

With receipt of payment and required information, Shoreline and their agent will help ensure the Marine Carrier Code application is complete and that all is in order. On advice by Shoreline or their agents, the signed originals of the Canadian MCC form (BSF329-4), Canada Customs Bond, POA and Attestation must be couriered to

ISL will forward the originals on your behalf. The CBSA may take up to 10 days to process your request upon receipt.

You will receive a confirmation and copy of the executed Canada Customs Bond, advising the assigned/bonded Canadian ACI Marine Carrier Code and Bond Number.

Notes:

- In item 17 on the CBSA application do you conduct overland movement of goods? If No this should be left blank. If YES - you will need all three blocks to say "See attached" and then on the third page complete the ports of discharge and the names of their agents.
- Section 8 of the Customs Bond must be signed by a witness on the principal's side. The witness does not have to be a notary.
